CUBSCOUTS

Cub Scout Packs can work with their Leaders and Committee Members to design a three section display board of your Pack's activities. You can add a display of some of your arts and crafts projects. Please include contact information of any activities outside of the unit as a resource for other Troops.

1st, 2nd and 3rd Place Awards will be given based on content, appearance, creativity and presentation. Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts will be judged separately. Scouts are expected to give a short presentation.

All displays will be in the Industrial Building at the Lake County Fairgrounds where Scoutapalooza will be held. Set up time will be 10 a.m. Saturday
Judging will take place at 1 p.m. Saturday

This is a great opportunity to share resources and give our Scouts new opportunities and adventures. So plan on being part of the Scout Display at the 2008 Scoutapalooza, May 16-18.
